HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

- All entries must be BVD tested
- **RINGWORM**
 - Animals with clinical signs of infectious disease(s) including Ringworm, Warts will not be accepted for entry to the Sale
 - Expo Show Committee procedure is to refuse entry of suspect animals to the Show premises.
 - The organisers reserve the right to isolate suspect animals for veterinary inspection by IHFA appointed vet at any stage during the Show and Sale.
 - The decision of the IHFA appointed vet will be final and binding”.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Confined to IHFA members
- All animals must be pedigree registered in the IHFA herdbook.
- Ownership details will be in accordance with CMMS data
- Dams to be classified VG or greater or calves bred from heifers, the G.Dam to be classified VG or greater
- The sale will follow the same format as last year with Catalogue being included at the rear of the Show Catalogue. (we can't guarantee the availability of the hard copy of the catalogue).
- The sale will proceed at 12.30, with a parade of sale calves and pedigree reading taking place at 12 pm Sharp.
- All Calves are being “Sold On the Market”. The vendor can decide to accept/reject the high bid on the fall of the hammer.
- All entries received will be promoted well in advance of the sale via social media and an online catalogue will be available.
- Sale order will be determined by draw carried out by IHFA / Emerald Expo Representatives.
- All details must be IHFA not later than March 27th 2020. (However, we strongly recommend you get them in sooner and send as much supporting information / photos as soon as possible if you prefer to properly promote your entry).
- Each entry is entitled to a 2-page spread if the information is sent in a timely fashion.
- Each entry is liable to €50 entry fee single page €65 entry fee for a double-page entry. Cheques payable to Emerald Expo.
- Entries are limited to 10 calves (with last year's vendors having first slots).

AUCTIONEERS CONDITIONS OF SALE:

The stock will be sold in euro guineas i.e. each bid is €1.05 and VAT at livestock rate will be charged on the .05 regulated by the Auctioneers.

The highest bidder to be the buyer, and if any dispute shall arise, the lot in dispute to be put up again and re-sold, or the Auctioneers may declare the purchaser at their discretion and their decision shall be final. The Auctioneers reserve the right to refuse the bid of any person without being called upon to give a reason for such action.

All lots to be paid for at the close of the sale. No lot or lots shall be removed from the sale premises until paid for and a pass-out slip obtained from the Auctioneer's clerk, but each and every lot shall immediately at the fall of the hammer be considered as delivered, and remain in every respect at the absolute risk of the respective purchaser or purchasers thereof, and shall be removed from the Sale premises at the purchaser's expense. Loading shall be the duty and responsibility of the purchaser.

The purchaser to give his name and dwelling place, and to remove the stock immediately after the sale.

NB All purchasers are hereby notified that all removals shall be supervised by the auctioneers and/or vendors and that in regard to the method and timing of removals the auctioneers and/or vendors directions must be adhered to and shall be final and binding on all parties.

Every care has been taken in the compilation of this catalogue but no responsibility is taken by the Auctioneers for any error appearing therein or in regard to the qualification of the animals and all purchasers must be on this distinct understanding.

All statements in the catalogue or any made by the Auctioneers at the time of sale, also the identification of the animals, are the entire responsibility of the Vendors. The Auctioneers take no personal responsibility for the correctness of such statements or identifies.

Neither the Auctioneers nor the Vendors will be responsible for any accident through fire or any other cause whatsoever; nor for any damage done by animals prior to, during or after the sale.

The Auctioneers act as Agents for the Vendors and any action taken by a purchaser must be against the Vendor and not against the Auctioneers, and "vice versa".

If any of these conditions are unfulfilled, the Vendors or the Auctioneers shall have power to re-sell the lot or lots concerned, retaining any surplus and charging any deficiency to the defaulter.
