Confined Classes 12 & 15: Exhibitors of animals who will qualify are those who have not been placed 1st or 2nd in any open class at the National Dairy Show, Emerald Expo, Tullamore, or Baileys in the last three years. NB: The exception is animals which have been shown in a confined class at any of the above shows can enter the confined class at Emerald Expo except the Champion of the Confined Section.

THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO AMEND THE CLASSES AS DEEMED NECESSARY

REGULATIONS

ENTRY FEE - €20 per animal & per group, payable with entries

- All entries must be registered in their relevant pedigree herdbook and the owner/exhibitor to be a member of the relevant herdbook.
- 2. Emerald Expo adopts IHFA Showing Rules, as approved by the Board of Directors on 20th May 2015. "The Showing Rules support good animal husbandry practice at shows while presenting a positive image to spectators. All exhibitors/owners/participants agree to abide by the IHFA Show Rules and local rules as applicable".
- 3. The highest 305 day lactation details must be filled in on the entry form for each entry. Dams highest yield will be required for Classes 1 3. This will be printed in the catalogue. The onus for furnishing correct details of entry rests on the exhibitor only.
- 4. A minimum of four animals is required to constitute a Class.
- 5. Production Class Any first prize winner can't compete in any other class except the Championship and Class 7 Confined Youngstock Class.
- 6. All original registration certificates must be available on the day of the show for inspection if so required by Show Committee.
- 7. EXHIBITOR BRED: "An animal is defined as exhibitor bred if the prefix of the animal is that registered to the exhibitor and the exhibitor was the registered owner/joint owner of the dam at the time of birth and registration." Ownership details will be in accordance with AIMS data.
- 8. The Show Committee will endeavour to have the catalogue correct in every way but it will not be responsible for any error or omission contained therein.
- 9. The Committee may, at it's discretion, seek additional information it deems necessary to confirm animal's age, number of calvings, number of months in calf, in order to confirm entry and eligibility and prize in the relevant class(es).
- 10. Stewards will be in charge of the judging ring and their decisions and judgments will be binding on all exhibitors/owners/participants.
- 11. The decision of the Judge will be final and no objections will be entertained.
- 12. All animals must arrive by 7pm on previous evening to show.
- 13. All animals must comply with veterinary regulations that apply to movement of cattle. They must be within 12 months TB round test.
- 14. RINGWORM "Animals with clinical signs of infectious disease(s) including Ringworm, Warts will not be accepted for entry to the Show and Sale. Expo Show Committee procedure is to refuse entry of suspect animals to the Show premises. The organisers reserve the right to isolate suspect animals for veterinary inspection by IHFA appointed vet at any stage during the Show. The decision of the IHFA appointed vet will be final and binding".
- 15. The Committee reserve the right to refuse entries, vary prize list of arrangement, or to remove any animal or other exhibit at any time during the show, and shall not be in any way liable for any claim for compensation or otherwise arising out of the holding, abandonment or alteration of the date of the show, nor for any claim arising out of or connected with the Show.
- 16. The Organising Committee will not be accountable for any incident howsoever arising or for any injury or damage howsoever sustained by any person whether a spectator, exhibitor or otherwise, while in attendance at or within the precincts of the Show, or for any damage by or to livestock, to vehicles or other property of whatever nature which have been brought on the premises for whatever purpose.
- 17. All cheques to be made payable to Emerald Expo.
